



Crop Diversification Initiatives

1. Horticulture Diversification

 With less than 0.5% area under horticulture of gross cropped area, it grows to 6.5% now, and intends to make it 16% by 2047. Big push for horticulture budget ~800 crore annually.

Mera Pani Meri Virasat (MPMV)

• Horticulture (9000 acres) in Kharif 2021 and targeted to diversify by 20,000 acres in 2022.

Produce Procurement & Risk Mitigation Initiatives

1. Meri Fasal Mera Byora (MFMB)

- Linked with e-kharid for selling of horticulture produce in mandi's.
- Around 1 lakh farmers registered, linked with horticultural farmer welfare schemes for online application and processing

Bhavantar Barpayee Yojna (BBY)

• 21 Horticultural crops have been covered with protected price and yield, an amount of Rs. 14.12 crore has been disbursed to farmers.

3. Insurance Schemes (MBBY)

• First State to launch an assurance based Mukhyamantri Baagwani Bima Yojna (MBBY) for 21 horticultural crops with very low farmer share of Rs. 750-1000 per acre & crop coverage of Rs. 30,000 to 40,000 per acre.

Horticulture Initiatives





- Fruits:
 - Covering 10000 ha per year.
 - Target to increase productivity from 15 MT to 25 MT by 2030.

- Vegetables:
 - To increase area twice and production thrice by 2030.
 - Target to increase productivity from 18 MT to 30 MT per ha.

Mushroom Initiatives

- Haryana is leading State for button mushroom production with more than 13000 MT/ annum.
- Big support to mushroom units: more than 50 units with year-round facility for mushroom production are being established each year.



Vertical Farming & Diversification

- Unique integration model for promotion of precision cultivation vegetable with MI, Staking, mulching.
- ~Rs. 500 crore provided @50-65% assistance.
- Productivity enhancement twice.

Impact:

- ~ 25,000 farmers benefitted.
- Around 3000 acres under poly house cultivation.
- More than 8000 acres under low-cost bamboo cultivation.
- 3000 acres under low-tunnels.
- 14,000 acres under mulching.
- Target to brought 1 lakh ha. under protected cultivation and 10 lakh ha. area under all horticulture crops by 2030 to cover 15% area in agriculture.
- Target to enhance productivity 2 times from 15 MT to 28 MT per ha. by 2030.



Water Resource Management

- Unique integration model: water farm pond + Orchard + Micro-Irrigation.
 - ~17000 farmers benefitted.
 - ~24,000 acres brought under catchment area with orchard establishment and micro-irrigation.
- Around 3115 water farm pond constructed
- Rs. 300 crore provided @70-100%.




Bhavantar Bharpayee Yojana (BBY)

- Price Protection Scheme (BBY) implemented in the State for horticulture crops
 - Scheme launched in 2018-19.
 - Farmers are compensated when wholesale price falls below protected price.
 - Protected price fixed for all 21 crops.
 - 21 fruit, vegetables & spice crops are covered.
 - Online portal: <u>www.bby.hortharyana.gov.in</u>
 - An amount of Rs. 14.12 crore has been disbursed to 5403 farmers.
 - Helped farmers to diversify

Mukhayamantri Bagwani Bima Yojana (MBBY)

• MBBY

- Scheme launched in 2021-22.
- 100% State Plan Scheme, and corpus fund of Rs. 10 crore has been created.
- No firm is empanelled, verification by third party & using technologies.
- To compensate the horticulture crop growers against weather vagaries.
- 21 fruit, vegetables & spice crops are covered.
- Very low premium @ 2.5% i.e. Rs. 750 for vegetables and Rs. 1000 for fruits per acre.
- Compensation fixed @ Rs. 30,000 for vegetables and Rs. 40,000 for fruits.
- Compensation @50% to 100%

- Risk Covered:
 - Hail Storm, Temperature- Frost Water Perils- Rainfall-Flood-Cloud-Burst-Canal/ Drain Break, Inundation, Wind Velocity, Fire, and heat wave.

Center of Excellence

- Established 11 Center of Excellence (CoE) and 3 are under establishment for different horticulture commodities with an investment of around Rs. 100 crore for fruits, vegetables, potato, bee-keeping, semi-arid crops, flowers, onion, etc.
 - Activities
 - <u>Latest technologies</u> under demonstration of precision farming, high-density plantations, protected cultivation, vertical farming, new crops, new varieties, organic farming, etc.
 - Provides more than <u>2 crore soil less hybrid vegetable seedlings</u> and more than 2 lakh grafted fruit plants to the farmers per year.
 - <u>Bee Policy-2021</u> to double honey production to 9000 MT in 5 years.
 - <u>Potato Policy-2022</u> to cover 15% seed potato business in India in 5 years.
 - <u>120 Village of Excellence (VoE) linked with CoEs.</u>




Potato Cluster






